Consider these four areas:

- **Person in care:** What do you see and hear? Is the person ready for you?
- **Environment:** Is the environment safe? Do you have the space you need to complete your task?
- **Task:** Have you checked the care plan? Does the task need to be done now?
- **Yourself:** Are you settled? Can you do the task safely?
